Highest inhabited regions in the world: Spiti Valley is set at an altitude of 4270 m (14000 ft) above sea level. This makes the valley one of the highest inhabited places in the world.

Monasteries galore: Spiti is noted for its many ancient monasteries, some of which date back over a thousand years. The iconic Key Monastery is set on a hilltop, while the Tabo Monastery, also known as the Ajanta of the Himalayas is another gem of the valley.

Unique cultures: Spiti Valley is known for its fusion cultures. It's fascinating to see a beautiful blend of Tibetan Buddhism and Indian influences that can be seen in the art and architecture of the place.

Day 0: Departure from Delhi (Departure point : Kashmiri gate\R.K Ashram Delhi) Day 1: Reach Manali, Self exploration. Overnight stay in Manali. Day 2 : Transfer to Kaza via Atal Tunnel & Kunzum La Overnigtstay in Kaza Day 3 : Visit Hikkim, Komic, Langza & Key Monastery. Overnigtstay in Kaza. Day 4 : Heading for Chandrataal lake via Chicham bridge & Losar Overnight stay in Batal/Chandratal. Day 5: Leave for Manali & Transfer to Delhi Overnight Journey to Delhi. Day 6: Arrival in Delhi by 5:00 to 9:00 am





- We will meet at the boarding point in Delhi Kashmiri gate / Majnu Ka Tila
- Leave from Delhi between 05:00 to 07:00 pm in the evening
- Start an overnight journey to Manali and socialize with your cotravelers.

Delu / Reach Manali – Relax & Self exploration

- Reach Manali early morning between 8:00 to 9:00 am & Check in to the hotel
- Take a moment to relax before setting out to explore the town.
- Places you can visit : Jogni waterfall, Vashisht temple, Mall road, Hadimba devi temple, old manali etc
- Night Briefing session for the following day
- Dinner, Overnight stay in Manali





Transfer to Kaza via Atal Tunnel & Kunzum Pass

- Early morning freshen up & get ready for the day
- Have breakfast and leave for Kaza
- Crossover to Lahaul by crossing the Engineering Marvel Atal Tunnel, and watch the terrain shift from lush green valleys to brown arid deserts.
- At 14,931 ft we cross another high altitude pass & the gateway to the Spiti Valley – Kunzum La.
- Enjoy the journey through picturesque landscapes. & Check into your Hotel
- Dinner & overnight stay in Kaza





Visit Key Monastery, Hikkim, Komic & Langza

- Wake up in the morning & have your breakfast
- Later we will leave for **Local sightseeing of Kaza**.
- Being remotely located atop a hill overlooking endless plains, the Key Monastery is a world famous center for learning and is an obvious choice for those seeking peace and calm.
- Visit **Hikkim**, where we have a chance to send postcards from the world's highest post office!
- The highest village in Asia **Komic, situated at a height of 4513** m, has a population of 84 people and is cut off from rest of the world for most parts of the year.
- Later visit **Langza**, walk back to the prehistoric era when Spiti was submerged by the Tethys Sea, as you explore a land very rich with fossils of Marine animals and plants which were here millions of years ago.
- Dinner & overnight stay in Kaza





Head to Chandrataal via Chicham bridge & Losar

- Early morning freshen up and leave for Chandrataal lake.
- On the way, visit the highest suspension bridge in Asia The Chicham Bridge
- Enroute we will cross **Losar** (the last village of Spiti Valley)
- However, make one last stop to witness another Spitian wonder Chandra Taal Lake.
- The mystical and beautiful Chandra Taal Lake or the Moon Lake is located at a height of 14,000 feet.
- Later check in to the Campsite.
- Dinner & overnight stay at the tents under the gaze of a million stars and the Milky Way Galaxy.

Note : In Chandrataal camp the sharing will be Quad & Penta







Day 5 Leave for Manali & Transfer to Delhi

- Today, we commence our way back on the Manali Kaza Road.
- We pass through some more stunning landscapes and reach Manali by afternoon.
- Board the bus Manali to Delhi
- Overnight journey to Delhi.







- Early morning arrive in Delhi by 7:00am 8:00am with memories of a lifetime.
- Say good bye to your co travelers.
