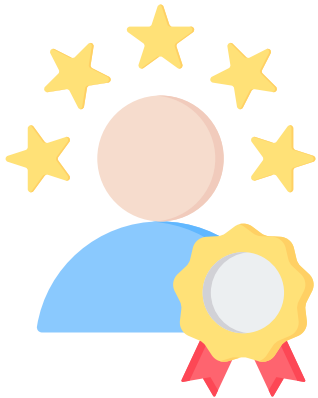

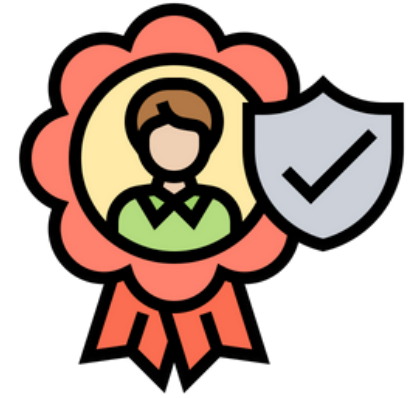

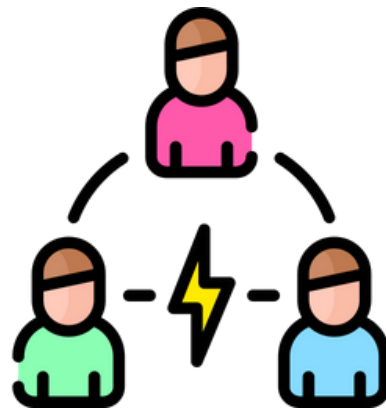

## **Here are some astonishing facts about India's Spiti Valley:**

**Cold desert:** Spiti Valley is also known as the Cold Desert. It is because of its high altitude geological location.

**Highest inhabited regions in the world:** Spiti Valley is set at an altitude of 4270 m (14000 ft) above sea level. This makes the valley one of the highest inhabited places in the world.

**Monasteries galore:** Spiti is noted for its many ancient monasteries, some of which date back over a thousand years. The iconic Key Monastery is set on a hilltop, while the Tabo Monastery, also known as the Ajanta of the Himalayas is another gem of the valley.

**Unique cultures:** Spiti Valley is known for its fusion cultures. It's fascinating to see a beautiful blend of Tibetan Buddhism and Indian influences that can be seen in the art and architecture of the place.

● **Day 5 : Leave for Manali & Transfer to Delhi**

Overnight Journey to Delhi.

● **Day 6 : Arrival in Delhi** by 5:00 to 9:00 am



# Day 0

## Departure from Delhi

- **We will meet at the boarding point in Delhi** – Kashmiri gate / Majnu Ka Tila
- Leave from Delhi between 05:00 to 07:00 pm in the evening
- **Start an overnight journey to Manali** and socialize with your co-travelers.

**\*Please Note:** Travelers will be notified regarding exact Trip Boarding Details before 24 hours before Trip Departure.







# Day 1

## Reach Manali – Relax & Self exploration

- Reach Manali early morning between 8:00 to 9:00 am & Check in to the hotel
- Take a moment to relax before setting out to explore the town.
- **Places you can visit :** Jogni waterfall, Vashisht temple, Mall road, Hadimba devi temple, old manali etc
- Night Briefing session for the following day
- Dinner, Overnight stay in Manali





# Day 2

## Transfer to Kaza via Atal Tunnel & Kunzum Pass

- Early morning freshen up & get ready for the day
- Have breakfast and leave for **Kaza**
- Crossover to **Lahaul** by crossing the Engineering Marvel – **Atal Tunnel**, and watch the terrain shift from lush green valleys to brown arid deserts.
- At 14,931 ft we cross another high altitude pass & the gateway to the Spiti Valley – **Kunzum La**.
- Enjoy the journey through picturesque landscapes. & Check into your Hotel
- Dinner & overnight stay in Kaza





# Day 3

## Visit Key Monastery, Hikkim, Komic & Langza

- Wake up in the morning & have your breakfast
- Later we will leave for **Local sightseeing of Kaza.**
- Being remotely located atop a hill overlooking endless plains, **the Key Monastery** is a world famous center for learning and is an obvious choice for those seeking peace and calm.
- Visit **Hikkim**, where we have a chance to send postcards from the world's highest post office!
- The highest village in Asia – **Komic, situated at a height of 4513 m**, has a population of 84 people and is cut off from rest of the world for most parts of the year.
- Later visit **Langza**, walk back to the prehistoric era when Spiti was submerged by the Tethys Sea, as you explore a land very rich with fossils of Marine animals and plants which were here millions of years ago.
- Dinner & overnight stay in Kaza





## *Day 4* Head to Chandrataal via Chicham bridge & Losar

- Early morning freshen up and leave for Chandrataal lake.
- On the way, visit the highest suspension bridge in Asia – **The Chicham Bridge**
- Enroute we will cross **Losar** (the last village of Spiti Valley)
- However, make one last stop to witness another Spitian wonder – **Chandra Taal Lake.**
- The mystical and beautiful Chandra Taal Lake or the **Moon Lake is located at a height of 14,000 feet.**
- Later check in to the Campsite.
- Dinner & overnight stay at the tents under the gaze of a million stars and the Milky Way Galaxy.

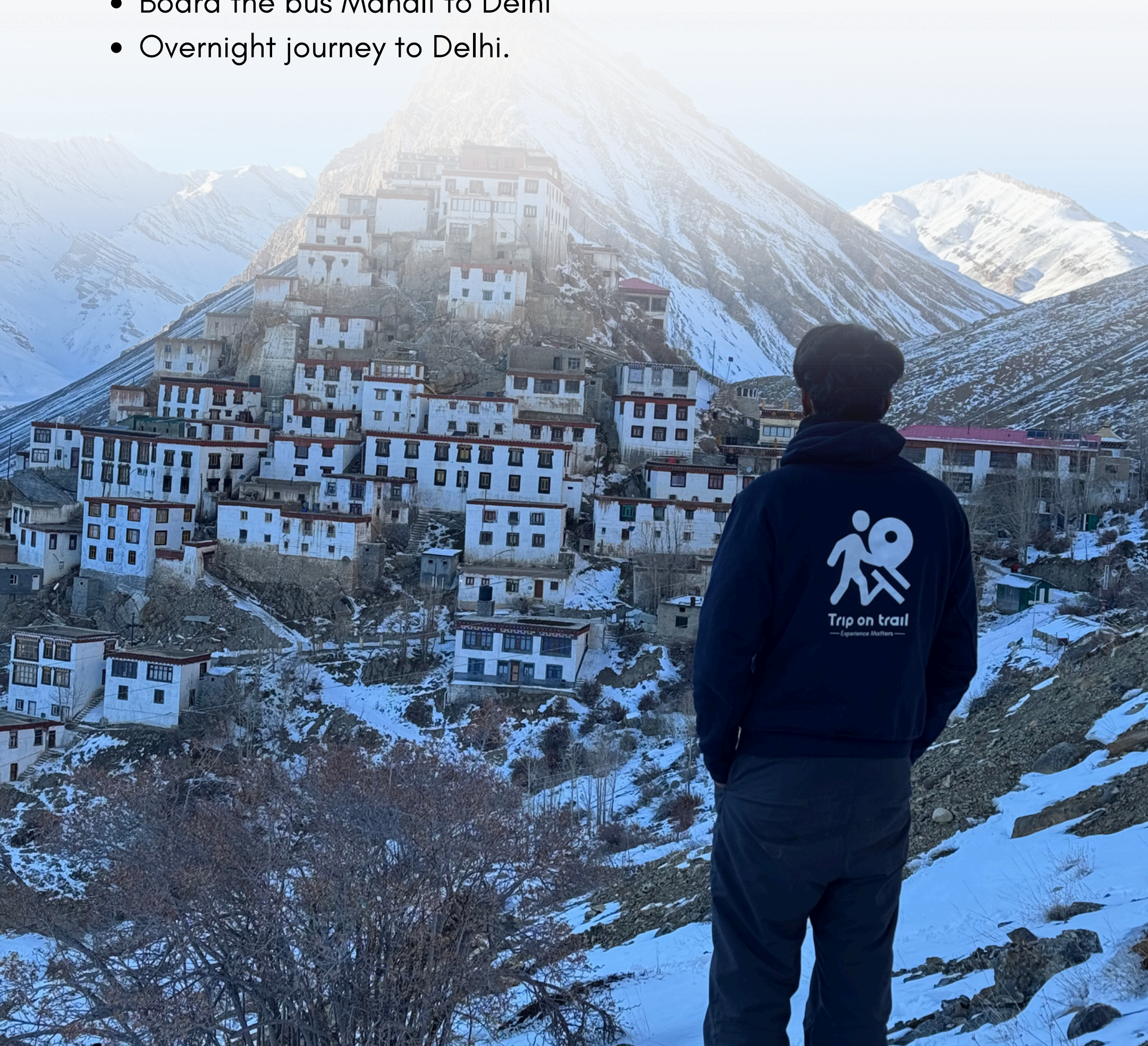

# *Day 5* Leave for Manali & Transfer to Delhi

- Today, we commence our way back on the Manali – Kaza Road.
- We pass through some more **stunning landscapes** and reach Manali by afternoon.
- Board the bus Manali to Delhi
- Overnight journey to Delhi.

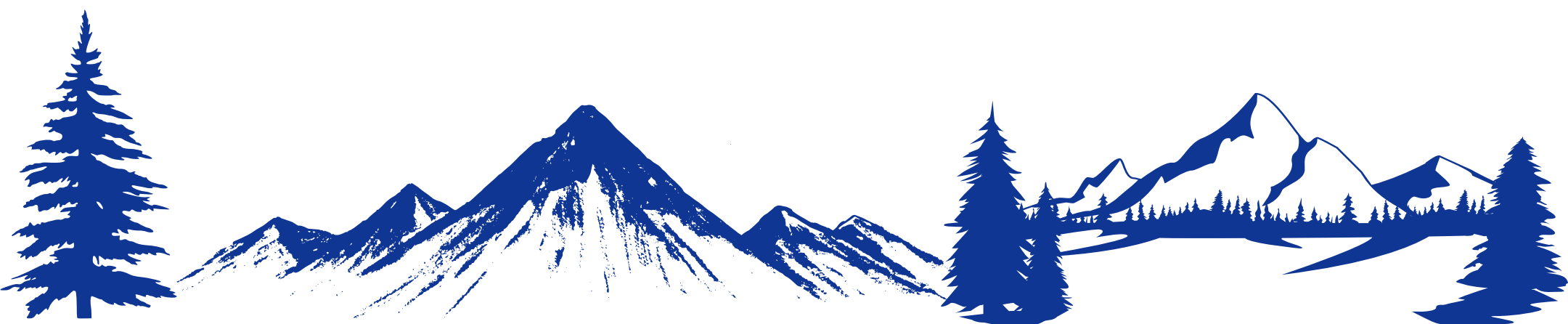
